- Master of Management

Robert Morris College has informed the Illinois Board of Higher Education of its intent to offer the Master of Management (MM) degree at the College's main campus in the Chicago region and off-campus at its locations in the North Suburban, West Suburban, Central, and South Metropolitan regions.

The MM degree is designed to prepare individuals from diverse undergraduate backgrounds for positions in functional administration. The curriculum focuses on policy implementation, resource allocation, planning and evaluation, financial measurement and integration of the students' specific concentration areas. The degree requirements include 28 credit hours of core and elective courses in business and 16 credit hours in concentration courses.

The MM builds on the College's experience in applied program delivery. The program is intended for practitioners seeking to enhance their effectiveness and assume greater responsibilities within their organizations. The College estimates an initial cohort of 15 students at each location.
