Robert Morris College has informed the Illinois Board of Higher Education of its intent to establish a campus in Elgin, Illinois which is located in the Fox Valley Region and where it will offer courses leading to the Bachelor of Business Administration and Associate in Applied Science – Business Administration degrees.

RMC's purpose of offering the Bachelor of Business Administration program in the Fox Valley Region is to serve associate degree graduates from the area's community colleges and other individuals with significant transfer credit. The objectives of the B.B.A. degree focus on the understanding of business and the development of accounting and management skills through the study of finance, management, marketing and economics. Graduates are prepared to assume management and supervisory positions in business or related fields. Ninety-six quarter hours of credit will be required to complete the B.B.A. for students who have already completed an A.S., A.A., or A.A.S. with a strong general education component; students who enter the program as freshmen must complete 188 quarter hours of credit.

RMC's Associate in Applied Science – Business Administration is designed for students seeking a solid business education in accounting, management, and marketing that will provide them foundation skills for a career in the business world. The A.A.S. – Business Administration requires 92 quarter hours of credit, including a general education component comprised of 36 quarter hours.

The College anticipates initial year enrollment of 40 students at the Elgin campus with enrollment of new and continuing students to reach 150 students by the fifth year.
