IN ILLINOIS HIGHER EDUCATION**

After the Report to the Governor and General Assembly was published in June 2005, the Illinois Board of Higher Education was notified of errors in select data tables. This item contains corrected versions of Tables 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 19, and 20 from the June 2005 report. The changes are as follows:

- Table 2: Due to revised data submitted by Governors State University, fall 2003 undergraduate enrollment numbers and percents at public universities decreased for all minority categories and increased for the White/Non-Hispanics and No Indication categories. The fall 2003 graduate/professional enrollment numbers and percents at public universities decreased for all minority categories and the No Indication category and increased for the Non-Resident Alien Category. The fall 2003 enrollment numbers and percents at all institutions increased for the White/Non-Hispanic and Non-Resident Alien categories and decreased for all others.
- Table 4: Fall 2003 enrollment numbers and the percent change from fall 2003 to fall 2004 decreased to account for revised numbers submitted by Governors State University.
- Tables 5 through 8: Governors State University fall 2003 enrollment numbers decreased and the percent change from fall 2003 to fall 2004 increased.
- Table 19: Fiscal year 2003 numbers for Black Hawk College, Daley College, Kennedy-King College, Elgin Community College, John A. Logan College, Southeastern Illinois College, Southwestern Illinois College, and Waubonsee Community College. Those numbers decreased for Black Hawk College, Kennedy-King College, Elgin Community College, John A. Logan College, Southeastern Illinois College, and Waubonsee Community College while the numbers for Daley College and Southwestern Illinois College increased. Fiscal year 2004 numbers increased for Illinois Valley Community College, Morton College, Rock Valley College, Triton College, Northern Illinois University, Northeastern Illinois University, and University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and the number for Wright College decreased.
- Table 20: Count and percent numbers decreased in all categories for Northeastern Illinois University. Count and percent numbers decreased in the Other category for Northern Illinois University and University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. The unduplicated total count and percent of fall 2003 enrollment numbers decreased for all three aforementioned institutions. All total by disability counts and percents also decreased.
