The attached July Regulatory Agenda highlights the additional rules to be reviewed and amended (as needed) during 2009:

- **Approval of Noninstructional Capital Projects (23 Ill. Adm. Code 1040).** The Board plans to review the rules currently on file and possibly update in accordance with the Board's review.
- **Illinois Consortium for Educational Opportunity Program (23 Ill. Adm. Code 2400).** The Board plans to repeal Part 2400 since the original implementing and authorizing legislation, the Illinois Consortium for Educational Opportunity Act, has been substantially amended by the General Assembly. The amended Act is implemented and authorized in Part 1080 which was adopted by the Board in 2006.
