rules during the coming year.

STATE OF ILLINOIS BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION

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The January 2013 Regulatory Agenda serves as a planning mechanism for the Board and a public communication of the Board's intent to adopt new rules and review existing rules during the upcoming year. The attached Regulatory Agenda highlights the following rules to be reviewed and amended (as needed) during 2013:

- Performance Metrics for Budget Recommendations (23 III. Adm. Code 900). Pursuant to Public Act 97-320 performance metrics must be adopted by the Board by rule. The metrics are to be designed to promote and measure student success in degree and certificate completion. The first set of metrics was developed in accordance with principles defined in the Act for the Board's FY 2013 budget recommendations for higher education. The Performance Funding Refinement Committee is currently working on refinements to the metrics for the FY 2014 budget recommendations. The Board intends to adopted new rules in 2013.
- Annual Public University Performance Report. The Board may propose the adoption of new IBHE rules to implement Public Act 97-610, effective January 1, 2012. Pursuant to the Act, the Board will compile and submit an annual report with information on new programs created, existing programs that have been closed or consolidated, and programs that exhibit low performance or productivity. Rules may be used to define terms and timelines for the report.
- Private Business and Vocational Schools (23 Ill. Adm. Code 1095). The Board adopted new rules in 2012 pursuant to the Private Business and Vocation Schools Act of 2012. The Board may seek to review these new rules in 2013 and may subsequently amend the rules.
