Springfield – Dr. Martha Kanter, Under Secretary for the U.S. Department of Education, and a national leader in postsecondary education and adult and career-technical education, will speak to the Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE) at its February 5 meeting. Her remarks will highlight key U.S. Department of Education initiatives targeted on increasing educational attainment in order to achieve the federal government's goal: to have the best educated and most competitive workforce in the world by 2020.

"We are very fortunate that Dr. Kanter will lead the Board in a conversation about critical policy initiatives aimed at increasing the number of college graduates in this country," Carrie J.
