BOARD ESTABLISHES TASK FORCE ON MILITARY PRIOR LEARNING ASSESSMENT

First meeting will be held February 3 in Springfield

SPRINGFIELD – The Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE) today announced creation of a Task Force on Military Prior Learning Assessment. It is conducting its initial meeting on February 3, 2016, in Springfield.

The Task Force was created as a result of the enactment of P.A. 99- 395 passed by the General Assembly in the spring 2015. The MPLA Task Force will study and make recommendations on how to best effectuate the recognition of military learning for academic credit, industry-recognized credentials, and college degrees through the use of Prior Learning Assessment.
