

## Higher Education in Prison: 2023-24 and 2024-25

This report summarizes the headcount of students enrolled in higher education programs within Illinois correctional institutions for the academic years 2023-24 and 2024-25, based on data provided by various universities.

- Overall Enrollment Trends: The total headcount of students enrolled in prison education programs in Illinois increased 9.7% from 93 students in 2023-24 to 102 students in 2024-25.
- Enrollment by University and Correctional Institution: Four universities offered programs across several correctional institutions:
  - Eastern Illinois University has the largest program, and it accounts for 49.5% of all students in 2023-24 and 48.0% in 2024-25. EIU enrolled 46 students in 2023-24, increasing to 49 in 2024-25, all at Danville Correctional Center.
  - Lewis University experienced an increase of 21.9%, growing from 32 students in 2023-24 to 39 in 2024-25. Their programs were at Sheridan Correctional Center (27 in 2023-24, 25 in 2024-25), Kewanee Life Skills Re-Entry Center (2 in 2023-24, 9 in 2024-25), and "Other Correctional Institutions" (5 students in both years, with data combined to protect student privacy).
  - Adler University also saw an increase, from 9 students in 2023-24 to 14 (+55.6%) in 2024-25. In 2023-24, all 9 students were at Big Muddy Correctional Center. In 2024-25, Big Muddy Correctional Center had 9 students, and East Moline Correctional Center had 5 students. It is important to note that zeroes in the data may indicate unreported data or the absence of a program in a given year.
  - Northeastern Illinois University was the only university that saw a decrease, with 6 students in 2023-24 at Stateville Correctional Center, and 2 students in 2024-25.
- Race and Ethnicity: Across the participating universities, African American students consistently
  represented the highest headcount among the reported racial categories. In the 2023-24 academic
  year, there were at least 37 African American students, 21 White students, and 18 Hispanic students
  enrolled across all programs.
  - Lewis University saw its number of African American students grow from 16 to 24 between the two academic years; in 2024-25, they comprised 61.5% of the university's prison program students.
  - Eastern Illinois University had the most racially diverse reported group. In 2024-25, its students were 32.7% African American (16 students), 24.5% White (12 students), and 26.5% Hispanic (13 students), with the remainder not reported.
  - Northeastern Illinois University reported 5 African American students and 1 student in a combined category for 2023-24.
- Age: The 40-55 age group consistently represents a large portion of the student body across the universities. For example, at Lewis University, this group accounted for 18 of 32 students (56.3%) in 2023-24 and 23 of 39 students (59.0%) in 2024-25.
  - Eastern Illinois University, the 40-55 age group also made up the largest share of students in both years.
  - Adler University's 2024-25 student body was primarily composed of students in the 31-39 and 40-55 age categories, with 5 and 6 students respectively.
