

## SPRING 2018 ENROLLMENT SNAPSHOT FOR ILLINOIS PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES

This following report provides a 2018 spring enrollment snapshot for Illinois public universities and includes information covering the last three academic years.

As shown in *Table 1*, in 2017-18 total FTE enrollment is down by -1.2% (-1,886 FTE) from 2016-17, but the decline is largely being driven by the -1.5% (-1,723 FTE) decline in undergraduate enrollment. Total graduate enrollment has remained relatively flat over the past three academic years.

## Undergraduate Enrollment (based on FTE)

As shown in *Table 2*, overall undergraduate enrollment at Illinois public universities declined by -3.5% (-4,204 FTE) from spring of 2015-16 to spring of 2016-17 and by -1.5% (-1,723 FTE) from spring of 2017-18. There was quite a bit of variation in spring enrollment between the public universities in comparing the last two years. Undergraduate enrollment growth was limited to the University of Illinois at Chicago and the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Governors State University experienced roughly flat undergraduate enrollment. Several schools experienced year over year declines around -10%: Western Illinois University (-10.9%), Southern Illinois University Carbondale (-9.6%), Chicago State University (-9.1%), and Eastern Illinois University (-8.1%).

## Graduate Enrollment (based on FTE)

Overall graduate enrollment (based on FTE) at Illinois public universities has been relatively flat the past three years. When comparing spring enrollment in AY 2017-18 to AY 2016-17, growth in graduate enrollment was limited to the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (+756 FTE) and the University of Illinois at Chicago (+171 FTE). Graduate enrollments were relatively flat at Illinois State University (+10 FTE), Northeastern Illinois University (-9 FTE), Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (-4 FTE) and Western Illinois University (-20 FTE). The University of Illinois at Springfield (-27.1%), Governors State University (-18.2%), and Chicago State University (-10.9%) all experienced notable declines in graduate enrollment.
