

Dear Student:

I am writing to share the difficult news that operations at Argosy University, Chicago have discontinued and the campus is closed. As I indicated previously, we have been working day and night to secure a path forward for campuses in receivership and, most importantly, for their students. While the campus will close, I want to be sure you have all of the information you need as you move forward.

We are working with our accreditors, state regulators and the U.S. Department of Education to provide options for our students. These include:

- Transferring to another higher education institution that is not part of DCEH (for a list of partner institutions, visit <https://www.dcedh.org/partner-institutions>). The list is updated frequently, so be sure to check back for updates.
- For students who elect not to continue their educational program, the USDE will provide them with the opportunity to apply for a closed school loan discharge. For additional information, students will be directed to the USDE website at: <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/repay-loans/forgiveness-cancellation/closed-school>.
- For students receiving Veteran Benefits who elect not to continue their educational program, the US Department of Veterans Affairs provides the following information regarding restoration of VA benefits, <https://www.benefits.va.gov/gibill/fgib/restoration.asp>.

All of these options are subject to the review of your academic transcripts and the transferability of the credits you have earned.

If you are in need of a copy of your academic transcripts, whether to order an official copy or to print an unofficial copy, log into the student portal and go to the “My Academics” tab. Please know that your financial ledger is available through the student portal as well. Go to the “My Finances” tab and then the “My account tab.” The information posted there is the most up to date financial statement available from the university.
