

FY25 Statewide Re-Enrollment Strategy FAQ

1. When is the proposal due date?

The proposal due date has been extended to December 3, 2024 at 12:00 noon.

2. What is the deadline to submit questions?

With the new proposal deadline of December 3, 2024 at noon, potential grantees should submit questions by November 25, 2024 to ensure time to post responses.

3. The timeline between Jan 1 and Jun 30, 2025 is relatively short. Are there specific expectations in terms of deliverables for that period?

Applicants should propose what they can realistically deliver within the grant period, consistent with what is outlined in the RFP.

4. Is there a possibility that the \$2M grant funds might be available beyond the Jun 30 deadline if the funds are not exhausted?

No. The funds are appropriated on a fiscal year basis, and all services must be provided by June 30, 2025. If additional funds are appropriated, they would cover the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025.

5. Does IBHE have a preference for sole vendor bids versus teaming arrangements?

IBHE does not have a preference.

6. What is the appetite for a more limited “Phase 1” focusing on a subset of schools and/or programs as a starting point?

Applicants should apply for what they deem is appropriate, consistent with the RFP.

7. Would participating institutions be responsible for, and capable of, providing learner data in a standard format as a starting point for the outreach campaign? If so, what information would be provided?

To the extent this is an essential component of an applicant’s proposal, the proposal should specify the information required.
