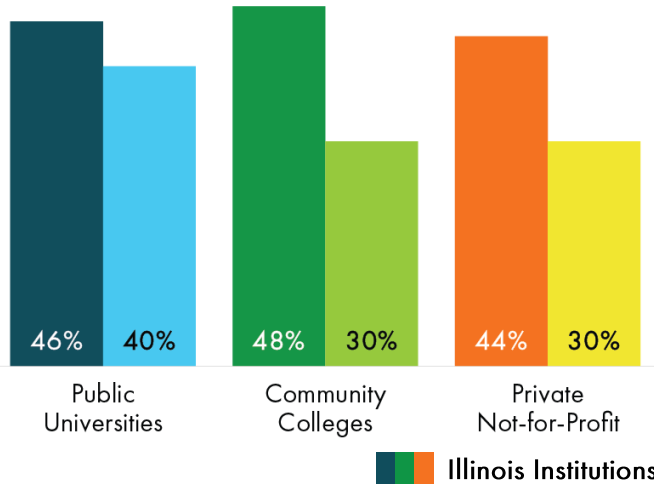

A COMPARATIVE PROFILE OF ILLINOIS HIGHER EDUCATION

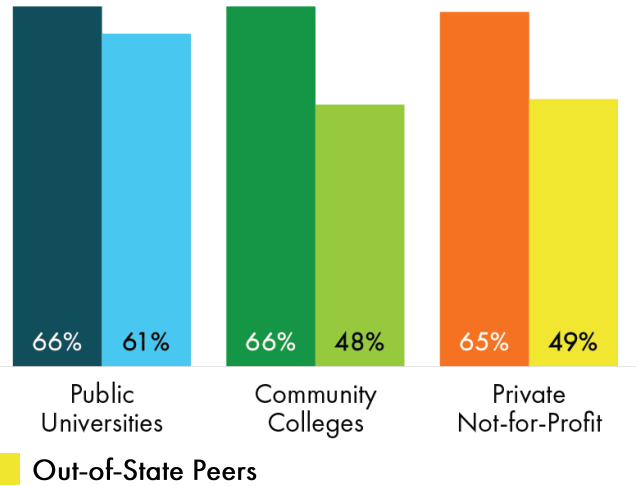
As a whole, Illinois colleges and universities serve a more ethnically/racially diverse group of undergraduate students than their out-of-state peers.

Proportion of Undergraduate Students Identified as Traditionally Underrepresented

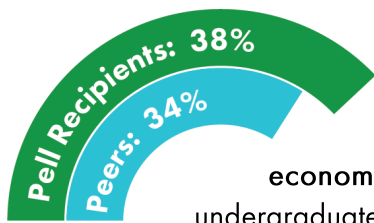
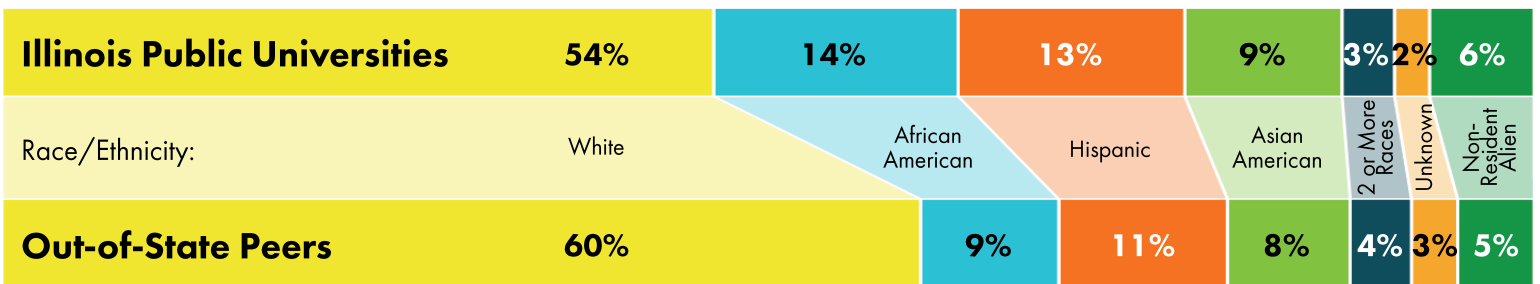


Index of Diversity

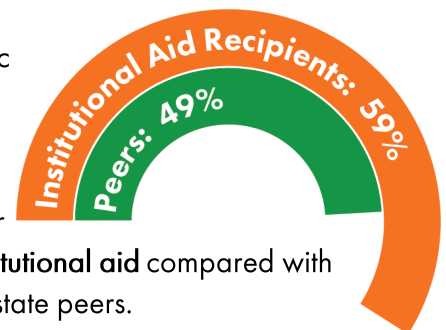
The likelihood that two undergraduate students randomly selected from the sample will belong to a different racial/ethnic group.



Relative to out-of-state peers, Illinois public universities serve higher proportions of African American and Hispanic students.



Illinois public universities serve a more economically diverse undergraduate student body than their out-of-state peers, as based on the proportion of Pell recipients.



Illinois public universities award significantly more of their students institutional aid compared with their out-of-state peers.
