



## PRELIMINARY FALL 2020 ENROLLMENTS IN ILLINOIS HIGHER EDUCATION

This report summarizes preliminary fall-term 2020 headcount and full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollments at colleges and universities in Illinois. It also includes enrollments in remedial/developmental education courses for Academic Year 2019-2020. Fall-term enrollments provide a “snapshot” of Illinois higher education enrollments on the 10th day, or census date, of the fall term.

### Preliminary fall 2020 enrollments by sector

Including enrollments at out-of-state institutions authorized to operate in Illinois, fall 2020 preliminary headcount enrollments at degree-granting institutions total 680,004 (see Table 4 for institutional level data). Fall 2020 FTE enrollments total 516,801. Enrollments by sector are shown below in Table 1.

### Total remedial/developmental education students

Table 2 summarizes unduplicated headcount of undergraduate students enrolled in at least one remedial/developmental course during a 12-month period (Academic Year 2019-20). Many students simultaneously enroll in college-level coursework and one or more remedial/developmental courses and are included in this data. Remedial/development course enrollment data disaggregated by sector and institution are presented in Table 5.

Table 3 summarizes the percent change in the preliminary headcount and FTE from 2019 to 2020. These differences are based only on those institutions that provided information in both years, so the changes reflected here are actual changes in enrollment patterns and not due to the response rate to the survey from one year to the next, nor do the changes reflect institutional closures. Undergraduate enrollment declined in all sectors except the for-profit private sector, which experienced a 2.5% year over year increase in headcount enrollment. The largest declines were in the community college and out-of-state sectors. Graduate enrollment increased at Illinois public universities and at for-profit private colleges for both headcount and FTE enrollments. The out-of-state sector experienced declines in both headcount and FTE at the graduate level. The year over year graduate-level enrollment changes for schools within the not-for-profit private sector were mixed and mostly flat.
