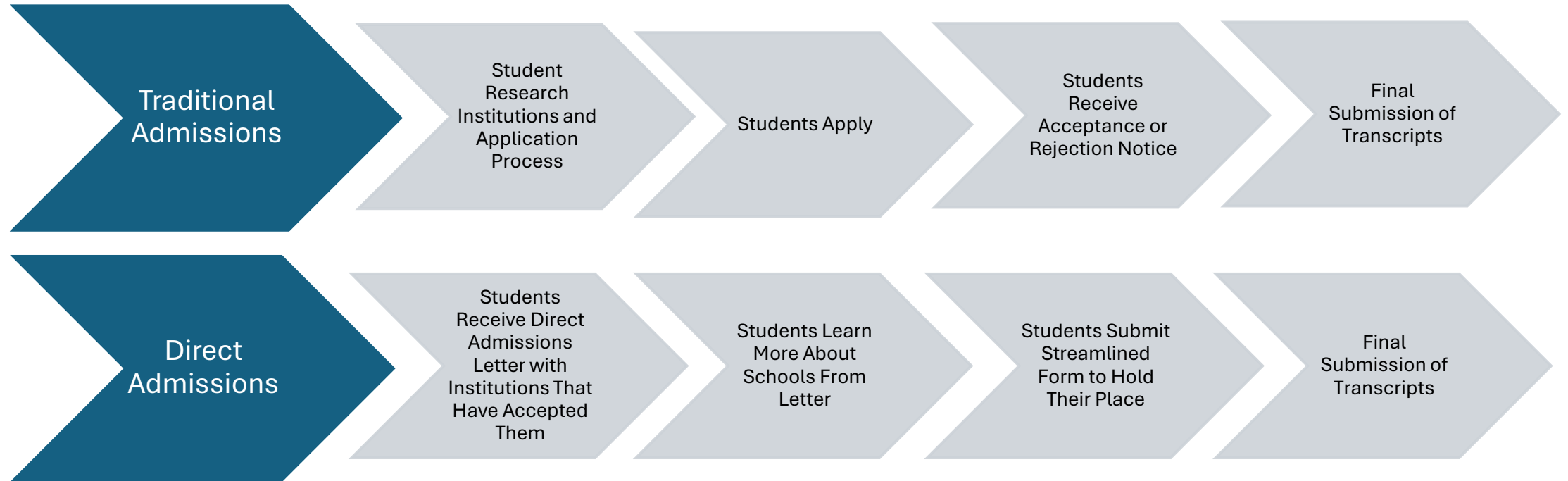

Traditional Admissions vs. Direct Admissions



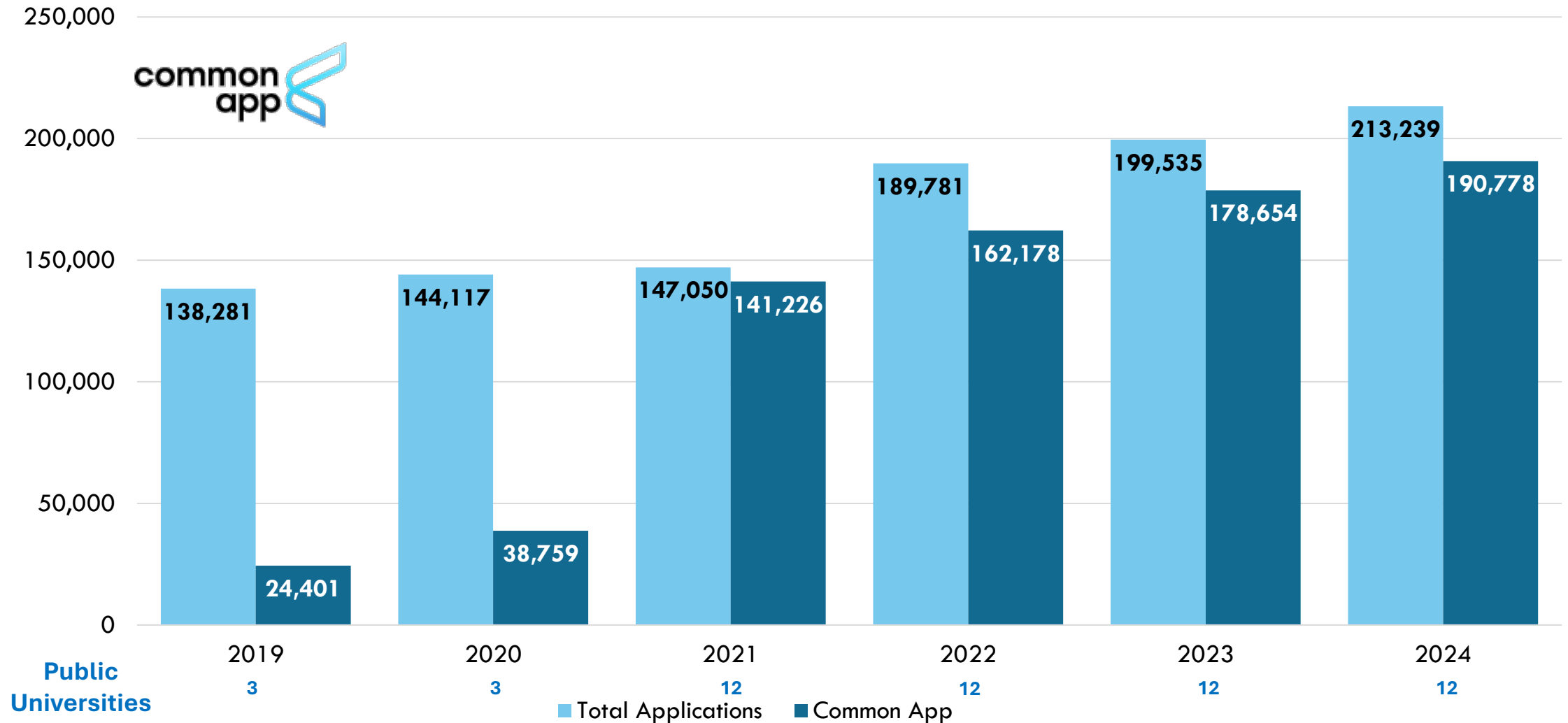
In both traditional and direct admissions, the admission is conditional upon submission of final transcripts.

Traditional Application simplified through use of The Common App

- The Common App is an online portal that allows prospective students to apply to multiple colleges with the same basic application. In 2021, all public universities began using the Common App. Illinois was only the second state in the country to have all public universities on the Common App.
- With the Common App students can see the array of great Illinois options for college, part of our effort to keep high school graduates in Illinois for college.

Common App has led to dramatic increases in applications, including for students from low-income families and students of color

Direct Admission Illinois - *One Click College Admit*



One Click College Admit is Illinois' free, quick, and stress-free direct admissions program into the state's participating universities. With only their GPA, graduating high school students and transferring community college students are directly admitted to one or more Illinois public universities!

One Click College Admit

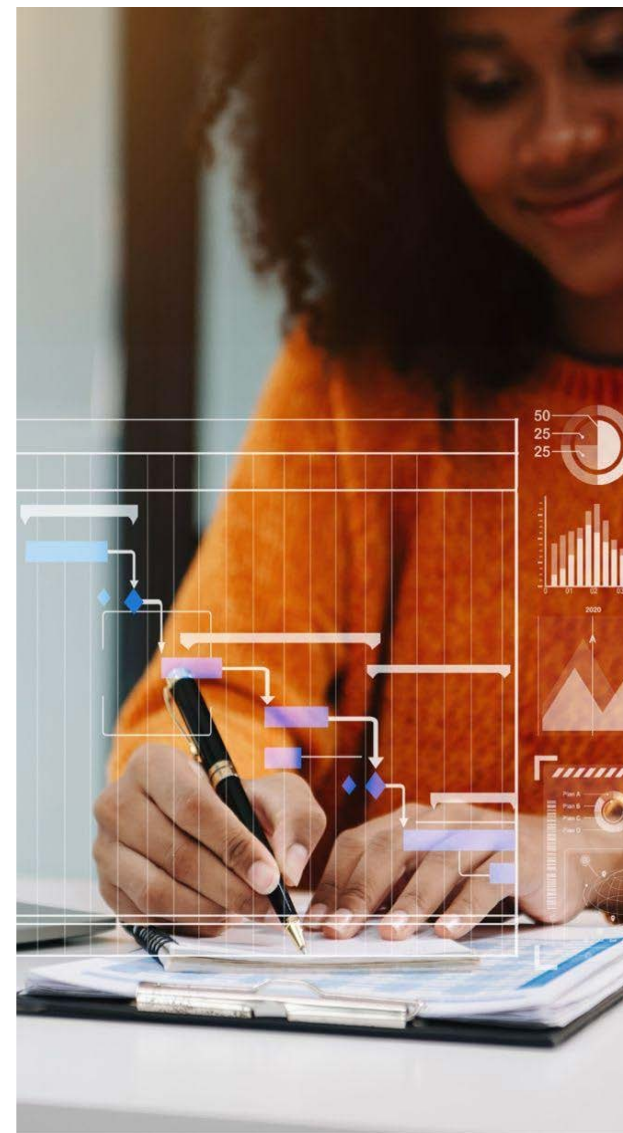
- Removes application fees, essays, and letters of recommendation
- Expedites the admission process
- Ensures students, who meet eligibility criteria, a spot at an Illinois university
- Reminds high school students of open enrollment at their local Community College



Illinois One Click College Admit Pilot

To receive *One Click College Admit* offers, students must:

- Create a Common App account (or have an existing account)
 - Indicate their permanent home address in IL
 - Enter their GPA and GPA scale (*One Click College Admit* guide provides step by step directions)
- That's it – at this point there is no need to complete the full application inside Common App
- Eligibility match process will run weekly
- Institutions verify with transcripts before enrollment





One Click College Admit Pilot Data

Data since the mid-January 2025 launch with 8 participating public universities

● Undergraduate enrollment

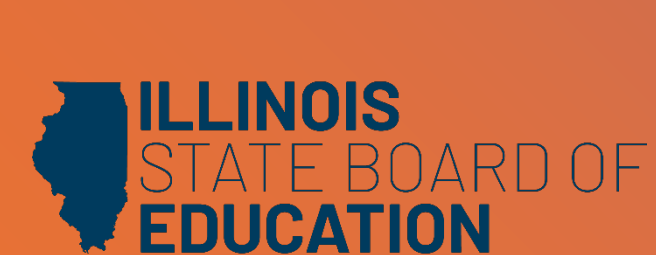
- 65,363 students have been offered One Click admission
- 3,240 have accepted the offer to at least one One Click institution
- 5,507 have indicated interest in at least one of the One Click institutions

● Student Profiles

- 3,102 of the 5,507 identified as first-gen
- 1,983 of the first-gen students applied to at least one of the universities and 99% of them were fee waiver eligible
- 2,508 of the 5,507 were low income (fee waiver eligible)
- 2,514 students who indicated interest in at least one of the institutions, and 1,617 who applied to at least one institution, live in a zip code below the median income level



Direct Admission Legislation



One Click College Admit

One Click

- Authorized via Public Act 104-0015
- High School and Community College (CC) Students included
- CC Transfer defined as student having earned 30 *transferable credit hours* and is currently enrolled at the IL CC
- 10 Public Universities participating and UIUC and UIC with required “outreach” plan
- Uses verified GPA

Process

- High School Juniors and CC Transfer Students must opt-in to allow their GPAs to be sent to ISAC for match process
- Universities must provide ISAC minimum GPA for match by 3/1/26, and every March thereafter
- High Schools must provide GPA of Juniors by July after Jr. year; ICCB will provide Transfer Student data by July
- ISAC will match for One Click offers

Process

- ISAC will provide matched data to CommonApp for high school students. CA will email student of the One Click offer; high school seniors will complete enrollment via CA
- ISAC / ICCB will communicate to Transfer Student of One Click admission offers; *TBD how Transfer Students act on offers*
- ISAC will provide Universities / Colleges names/contact info of students who received One Click offers to their institutions

Implementation Timeline: Fall 2027 Enrollment

Fall 2025

- **August 2025 Opt-in Process opens** Parents of high school juniors and community college transfer students complete the opt-in form via ISAC platform.

Spring 2026

- **Beginning March 1, 2026 (Annually after)** Public universities submit GPA admission standards; UIC/UIUC submit out-reach and access criteria incl. GPA.
- **Opt-in Platform closes** May 22nd and every Friday before Memorial Day each year thereafter.

Summer 2026

- By **July 1, 2026**, High schools provide junior/rising senior student data to ISAC for admission determinations. Community colleges provide transfer student data to ISAC for admission determinations.

Fall 2026

- **September 2026** First One Click offers issued for enrollment in Fall 2027.

August 1, 2029

- Program report submitted to the Governor and General Assembly.
