RECOMMENDATIONS

Focused on three aspects of the Act

Peer support

Health care ratios

Technical assistance center

PEER SUPPORT

Use a peer-mentoring approach, rather than expect therapist level skills from undergraduates

HEALTH CARE RATIOS

Establish minimum access of standard physical and mental health care rather than focus on a counselor:student ratio.

 Support for telehealth options critical for rural and diverse populations

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE CENTER

Encourage sharing best practices

- ► IBHE is the logical host due to their expertise in data handling and existing connections in higher education
- Could necessitate an IBHE position with relevant expertise
