The position is responsible for maintaining, improving, and managing web-based applications used for academic program approval and grants administration and for managing the IBHE website.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Develop and support both internal and public-facing web applications, including internal reporting interfaces that are database-driven
- Provide vision and manage the planning and implementation of web-based applications
- Consult with internal clients and other team members to design and develop solutions that are interactive, database-driven, and user-friendly
- Code, test, and debug applications according to specifications
- Manage updates to the IBHE website
- Design and develop back-end database interfaces to applications
- Implement physical changes to databases; code and test SQL, applying knowledge of database management
- Document and communicate changes to programs, applications, and databases
- Maintain version integrity and version control of applications and databases

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

- Bachelor's degree in computer science from an accredited college or university; or equivalent combination of education and experience in the computer science field
- Experience must include a minimum of one year of back-end database development experience or equivalent certifications and two years of experience with web-based application development
